The "Remembering Silenced Voices - Through the Eyes of a Survivor" exhibit commemorates the 25th anniversary of the persecution of Sri Lanka's Tamils in the anti-Tamil pogrom of July 1983. A must-see and powerful collection, it showcases the haunting survivor stories and inspirational testimonials of the Canadian immigrant experience. The events of July 1983 are particularly poignant for the global Tamil population, being one of many key events that drove over a quarter of the Sri Lankan Tamil population to flee to western countries like Canada that kindly accepted them.
